

PRIVACY CONSIDERATIONS

 UBC Zoom accounts are hosted on Canadian servers, however, this is not the case with free Zoom accounts



IF a session is being recorded:

- Students can maintain their privacy by using an alias, turning off their microphone and camera
- Ensure session recordings are kept secure and confidential
- Notify students in advance if session recordings are expected to be reused or shared outside the designated course space
- Refrain from sharing personal information during recorded sessions
